Quarterly Update #1 - 2015/08/01

USAFA Gymnastics Alumni, Parents, and "Friends of USAFA Gymnastics,"

I'm sending you this letter on behalf of the Honorary Chairs and Committee Members for the USAFA Gymnastics Funds Campaign. This is the inaugural edition of what will become a quarterly update.

In the spring of 2014, during the final rounds of the Air Force budget deliberations for Fiscal Year 2015, both the USAFA Men's and Women's Gymnastics Teams were identified for complete elimination. They were among six USAFA intercollegiate teams that were deemed unaffordable in the USAFA Program Objective Memorandum (POM) submission because of budget cuts imposed upon the Academy. Fortunately, in the very last hour, the Air Staff shifted funds from other programs to sustain funding for all six of those teams.

Those events were an awakening for many USAFA gymnastics alums and parents who heard the alarming news. We immediately recognized the need to mobilize. Our mantra: the gymnastics teams should never again end up in such a precarious situation. We suspect that you feel the same way.

Following many discussions and planning efforts with Kim Broughton ('03), Chuck Schweiss ('82), Ted Brewer ('82), Mark Hyatt ('74), and Lou Burkel (head coach for over two decades) and through partnership with the Air Force Academy Athletic Corporation (AFAAC) and the USAFA Endowment (UE), we collectively developed a viable way ahead to preserve and sustain our USAFA gymnastics heritage and the opportunity for future USAFA cadets to have the full gymnastics opportunity that earlier generations enjoyed and valued.

In 2008, the USAFA Endowment established both a Men's Gymnastics Team Fund and a Women's Gymnastics Team Fund. Their purpose: to help gymnasts attain that additional "Margin of Excellence" in gymnastics ability, character development and leadership development beyond the funding available in the teams' programmed budgets.

In late 2014, General Steve Lorenz, President and CEO of the USAFA Endowment, approved our establishment of a <u>USAFA Gymnastics Funds Campaign</u> in order to solicit more substantial donations to bolster the Endowment's existing gymnastics team funds. And in the spring of 2015, Dr. Nancy Hixson, the Interim CEO of the AFAAC, also pledged the AFAAC's support of our campaign.
